It is intended for various indoor public spaces such as cinemas, theatres, hospitals and prisons, as acoustic wall panels or sunscreens, as well as for transportation such as cruise-ships, trains and buses.

Available in different weave patterns and over one thousand colours, as well as custom prints such as company logos, FLAMLINÉ is certified by the German building authorities under DIBT Z.56.429-140 and meets international standards DIN EN 13501: A2-s1, d0 (EU) and DIN 4102-A2.

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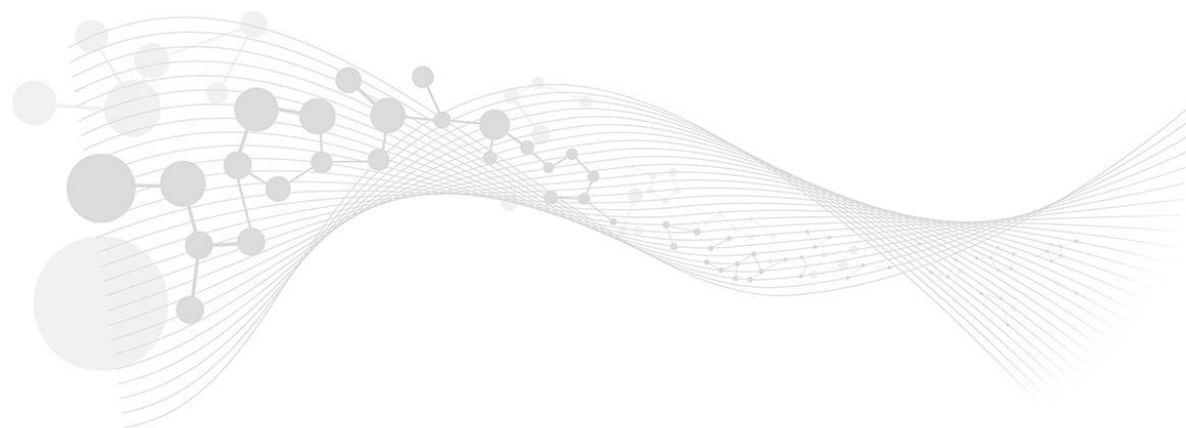
